The dues schedule for the 2014-2015 season of the **Pi-Cone South Math League** is listed below. You need to pay for each team of 10 (or less) for which you want a score posted on the Pi-Cone South (**PCS**) web site and/or on the Maine Association of Math Leagues (**MAML**) web site.

Each high school must pay the minimum of \$410 to compete for one season; this includes the fee for the State Meet. Other teams per school may compete, but keeping their scores is optional; if more than one team's score per school is sent to and posted on either of the league's two web sites (**PCS** or **MAML**), that school will be charged \$60 for each additional team. With this in mind, if a coach wants more than one team to compete, but does not want that team's score posted on a web site, it is that coach's responsibility to keep that team's score from being sent to and posted on either web site.
